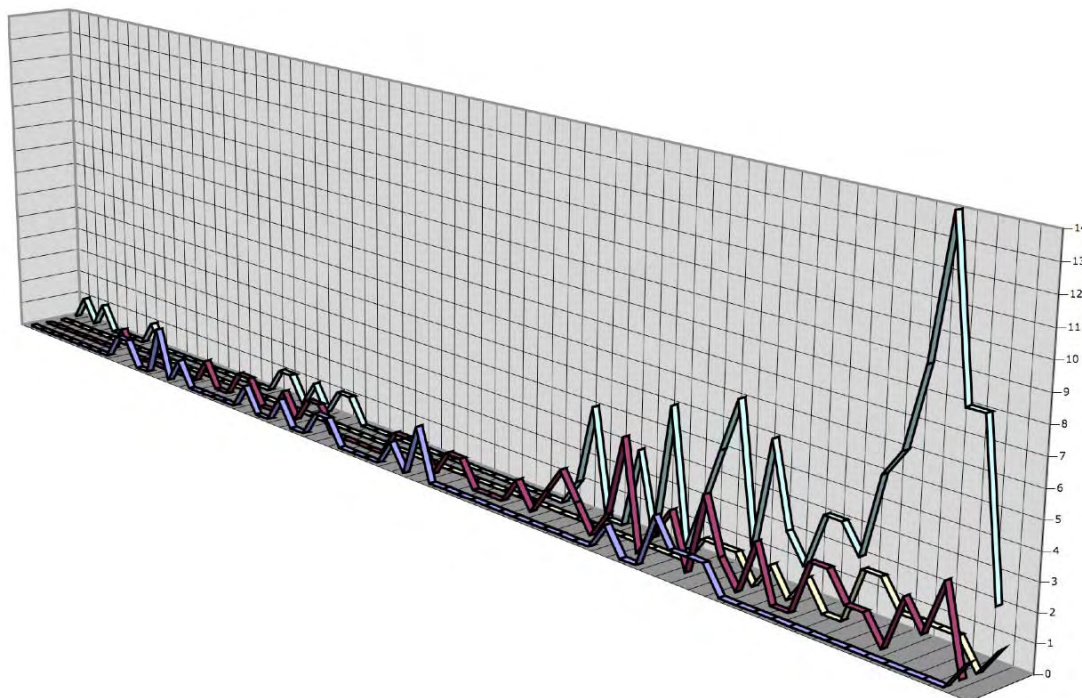

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

As of 9 Sep. 2007, al-Qaeda's as-Sahab Media released 74 videos in 2007, averaging a release every three days. With more than three months in 2007 to go, this makes it already the highest annual release rate for video material since al-Qaeda's inception. The previous highest was in 2006 when as-Sahab released 58 videos, averaging a release every six days. As-Sahab's unprecedented audio/video release tempo and related factors indicates a likely continued increase in production/release capability and other changes in its operations.

May 2007 was the highest release month ever with 17 videos released. The second highest was Jul. 2007 when as-Sahab released 12 videos. Jun. 2006 was third highest with 11 releases.

In 2006, as-Sahab released five new Osama bin Laden audio/video statements, making this the second highest number of bin Laden statements in any one year. During the first half of 2006, Ayman al-Zawahiri released the same number of new audio/video statements as his highest volume in any prior year, which was eight in 2005.

As of 9 Sep. 2007, al-Zawahiri has released seven videos featuring audio statements and three with video statements in 2007. In 2006, al-Zawahiri released 13 new audio/video statements (1 audio, 12 video), the highest number by al-Zawahiri in any one year ever. In addition to these statements, al-Zawahiri also appeared in three other videos making introductory and other remarks. If you count these appearances, it would bring his total number of video appearances in 2006 to 15.

As of 9 Sep. 2007, Osama bin Laden has released one video statement in 2007. He was two short in 2006 of making it the highest number of new statement releases ever in any

one year by both al-Qaeda leaders. If all as-Sahab audio/video statement releases are counted for al-Zawahiri and bin Laden in 2006, not just new statements, al-Zawahiri was at 15 releases and bin Laden tied with his highest at six releases. Al-Zawahiri's number goes to 18 in 2006 if you count videos in which he made introductory or other remarks.

When taking into consideration this dramatic increase in production levels for senior al-Qaeda leadership, combined with other as-Sahab video releases, it is clear that significant resources and efforts are being expended by as-Sahab to produce and release more videos than ever before and with consistently faster turnaround times than ever previously seen based off initial assessments.

In 2007 so far, al-Zawahiri releases account for 14% of as-Sahab releases, while Others account for 73%. Releases by Abu Yahya al-Libi account for 12% and Osama bin Laden's 1%. The increase in other material is representative of recent efforts by as-Sahab to release shorter operational videos from Afghanistan as well as video statements by other al-Qaeda figures such as Abu Nasir al-Qahtani, Omar al-Faruq, and Abu Laith al-Libi.

METHODOLOGY

This report focuses on all audio/video releases by al-Qaeda's as-Sahab Institute for Media Production from 2002 to 9 Sep. 2007. For the purposes of this report, releases are defined as a deliberate effort to produce and distribute audio/video material on VCD, the Internet, directly to the media or through other means designed to achieve public exposure. The qualifying characteristic used to calculate monthly totals is not whether the statement contained in the video is new but rather did as-Sahab expend effort to produce and release the material. For example, the 29 Apr. 2006 release of Osama bin Laden's reading of the poem "Thoughts Over al-Aqsa Intifadah" is a 2006 release, however, the reading of the poem predates 9-11 and portions of it were available broadly for some time. However, the release was counted because it was the first broad release of it in that version and it was a deliberate release by as-Sahab as opposed to someone simply finding an old copy and making it more accessible.

The criteria used for calculations is designed to provide a complete picture of as-Sahab's messaging efforts in terms of its focus, resource allocation and ultimately al-Qaeda's messaging strategy.

When classifying a video as Osama bin Laden, Ayman al-Zawahiri or Other, only those videos that were statement videos, as opposed to produced videos, were considered for the first two categories. All other videos, to include produced videos, were placed into the Other category. For example, the 2 Sep. 2006 release of the "An Invitation to Islam" video was listed as a video statement by Azzam al-Amriki with a video introduction by Ayman al-Zawahiri. It was not considered an al-Zawahiri video statement for the purposes of the QMS and similar reports.

ANALYSIS

As of 9 Sep. 2007, al-Qaeda's as-Sahab Media released 74 videos in 2007, averaging a release every three days. With more than three months in 2007 to go, this makes it already the highest annual release rate for video material since al-Qaeda's inception. The previous highest was in 2006 when as-Sahab released 58 videos, averaging a release every six days. As-Sahab's unprecedented audio/video release tempo and related factors indicates a likely continued increase in production/release capability and other changes in its operations.

May 2007 was the highest release month ever with 17 videos released. The second highest was Jul. 2007 when as-Sahab released 12 videos. Jun. 2006 was third highest with 11 releases.

In 2006, as-Sahab released five new Osama bin Laden audio/video statements in 2006, making this the second highest number of bin Laden statements in any one year. The highest number of statements by bin Laden was in 2004 when he made six audio/video addresses. The third highest volume was in 2003, when he made four audio/video statements.

During the first half of 2006, Ayman al-Zawahiri released the same number of new audio/video statements as his highest volume in any prior year, which was eight in 2005.

As of 9 Sep. 2007, al-Zawahiri has released seven videos featuring audio statements and three with video statements in 2007. This represents a shift in al-Zawahiri's previous release pattern that favored video statements over audio statements. In 2006, al-Zawahiri released 13 new audio/video statements (1 audio, 12 video), the highest number by al-Zawahiri in any one year ever. In addition to these video statements, al-Zawahiri also appeared in three other videos making introductory and other remarks. If you count these appearances, it would bring his total number of video appearances in 2006 to 15.

As of 9 Sep. 2007, Osama bin Laden has released one video statement in 2007. He was two short in 2006 of making it the highest number of new statement releases ever in any one year by both al-Qaeda leaders. If all as-Sahab audio/video statement releases are

counted for al-Zawahiri and bin Laden in 2006, not just new statements, al-Zawahiri was at 15 releases and bin Laden tied with his highest at six releases. Al-Zawahiri's number goes to 18 if you count videos in which he made introductory or other remarks.

When taking into consideration this dramatic increase in production levels for senior al-Qaeda leadership, combined with other as-Sahab video releases, it is clear that significant resources and efforts are being expended by as-Sahab to produce and release more videos than ever before and with consistently faster turnaround times than ever previously seen based off initial assessments.

These higher production/release levels are representative not only of an increased volume of newly recorded messages from al-Qaeda but also new efforts by as-Sahab to make accessible previously unavailable material.

Increases in as-Sahab production levels did not jump to a higher production rate and simply sustain but rather are continuing to trend upward. The upward trend began around Aug. 2005 and has continued to accelerate for the past two years. When factoring in subtitled and voiceover versions made for different languages, production levels are even higher than what is represented here.

In the 2002 to 2007 period, 11% of as-Sahab's releases were Osama bin Laden releases and 24% were Ayman al-Zawahiri's. Prior to 2005 releases from bin Laden and al-Zawahiri ran in close parity with each other.

In 2006, bin Laden releases account for 10% and al-Zawahiri's 26%, while other releases stand at their highest percentage in the period, 55%. Abu Yahya al-Libi statements account for 9%.

In 2007 so far, al-Zawahiri releases account for 14% of as-Sahab releases, while Others account for 73%. Releases by Abu Yahya al-Libi account for 12% and Osama bin Laden's 1%. The increase in other material is representative of recent efforts by as-Sahab to release shorter operational videos from Afghanistan as well as video statements by

other al-Qaeda figures such as Abu Nasir al-Qahtani, Omar al-Faruq, and Abu Laith al-Libi.

Osama bin Laden & Ayman al-Zawahiri – Audio vs. Video

Every time a new audio statement appears from Osama bin Laden, countless media reports and discussion begins within moments to speculate and find meaning as to why bin Laden did audio instead of video and why we see al-Zawahiri in video so much more. Many of these reports carry an air of currency stating that bin Laden is "now" using audio or why "this time" is he using audio. Is it because he's sick? Is he dead? Do we see al-Zawahiri more because he's taken over for bin Laden? All are wonderful soundbites. However, there is nothing more dangerous than an isolated fact without context.

The simple truth is that in all of the 19 audio/video statements Osama bin Laden has released in more than five years, only two have been video statements. This accounts for only 11% of bin Laden's statements from 2002 to 9 Sep. 2007. To attempt to attribute new significance to a statement recently released by OBL as being in audio form rather than video ignores the fact that this is exactly what he has always done for more than five years with only two exceptions. In other words, audio releases from OBL are what is expected based on his current release patterns. If OBL appears in video, this would be a significant variation.

Al-Zawahiri on the other hand has always done a fair amount of both audio and video statements. In 2002-2003, al-Zawahiri only released audio statements but then in 2004 he began to release video statements in increasing volume over the course of the next three-plus years. In the period from 2002 to 9 Sep. 2007, 42% of al-Zawahiri's statements were audio and 58% were video statements. In 2005 and 2006, al-Zawahiri issued significantly more video statements than audio. In 2007, al-Zawahiri reversed this trend and has begun releasing more audio statements than video. As of 9 Sep. 2007, al-Zawahiri released 10 statements of which only three were video. This is the first time since 2004 that the number of audio statements for al-Zawahiri has outnumbered video statements.

Abu Yahya al-Libi Visibility

In 2007, as of 9 Sep. 2007, al-Zawahiri releases account for 14% and releases by Abu Yahya al-Libi account for 12%. In 2006, al-Libi was the second most visible face of al-Qaeda through as-Sahab after only Ayman al-Zawahiri. If you count just video appearances in 2007, he is currently the most visible face of al-Qaeda, surpassing al-Zawahiri in video statements. He is the second most visible voice after only al-Zawahiri for the period running from 2006 to 9 Sep. 2007.

In addition to addressing local issues pertaining to Afghanistan, he now regularly releases addresses pertaining to al-Qaeda issues from around the globe ranging from Somalia to Iraq to HAMAS to the Danish Cartoons controversy.

If you count al-Libi appearances on Labaik videos in addition to as-Sahab releases his prominence grows even more, making him one of the most visible and frequent faces of the global jihad.

as-Sahab Video Turnaround Times

Beginning in 2006 al-Qaeda began responding to current events in the news cycle with a responsiveness and speed it never had before. This trend has continued through 2007 and is partly why the rate of releases has so greatly increased. In 2006, based on video dating analysis of releases, there were turnaround times from event to video release that may have been as short as 5-7 days. When making these calculations, the event date and the release date were both counted. In most cases the actual turnaround times are faster than what is shown here due to various factors.

The ability of al-Qaeda to respond to an unpredictable event in the news cycle within as little as a week with a fully produced video release demonstrates a significant dedication of resources and skill in its messaging capability.

VIDEO APPEARANCES IN AS-SAHAB VIDEOS IN 2006

The following is a breakdown of video appearances in as-Sahab videos released in 2006

- Ayman al-Zawahiri has appeared in 15 videos. Twelve of those appearances were video statements, two were intros and another consisted of limited remarks in the video released on 6 Jul. 2006 to commemorate the Jul. 2005 London bombings. Old previously seen video statements were used in the “Knowledge is for Acting Upon: The Manhattan Raid” video but it is not counted here.
- Azzam al-Amriki has appeared in three videos. Two are considered to be video statements and one is part of the produced video, “Knowledge is for Acting Upon: The Manhattan Raid”.
- Abu Jihad al-Masri has appeared in one video, which is considered to be a video statement.
- Abu Yahya al-Libi has appeared in four videos. All four are considered to be video statements.
- Abu Nasir al-Qahtani has appeared in one video, which is considered to be a video statement.
- Omar al-Faruq has appeared in one video, which is considered to be a video statement.
- Osama bin Laden has released five audio statements which have appeared in five videos. He appeared in old but never before seen footage in the produced video, “Knowledge is for Acting Upon: The Manhattan Raid”.
- Mullah Dadullah has appeared in one video, which is considered to be a video statement.

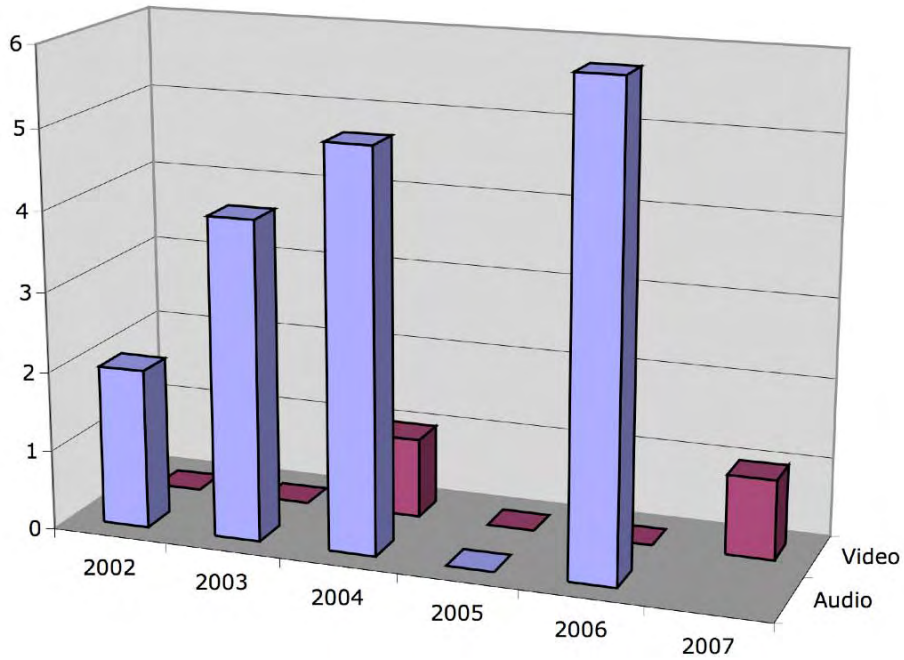

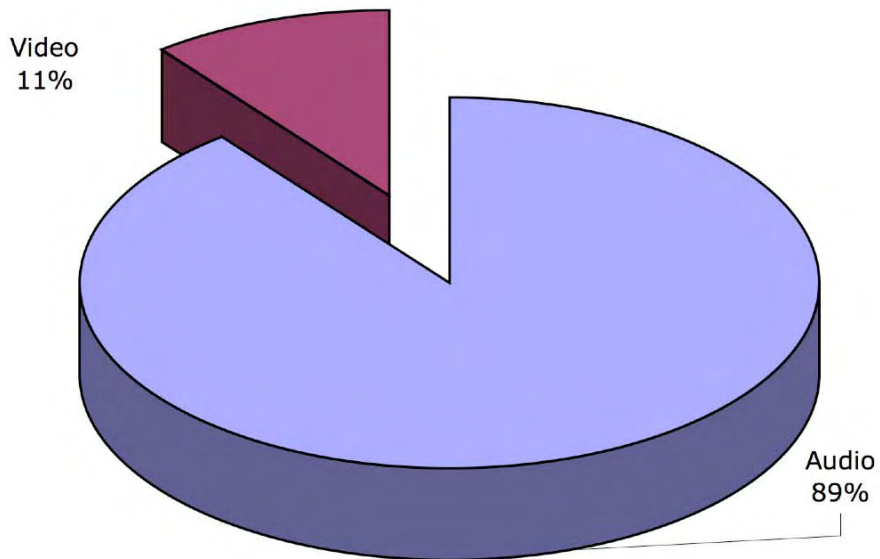

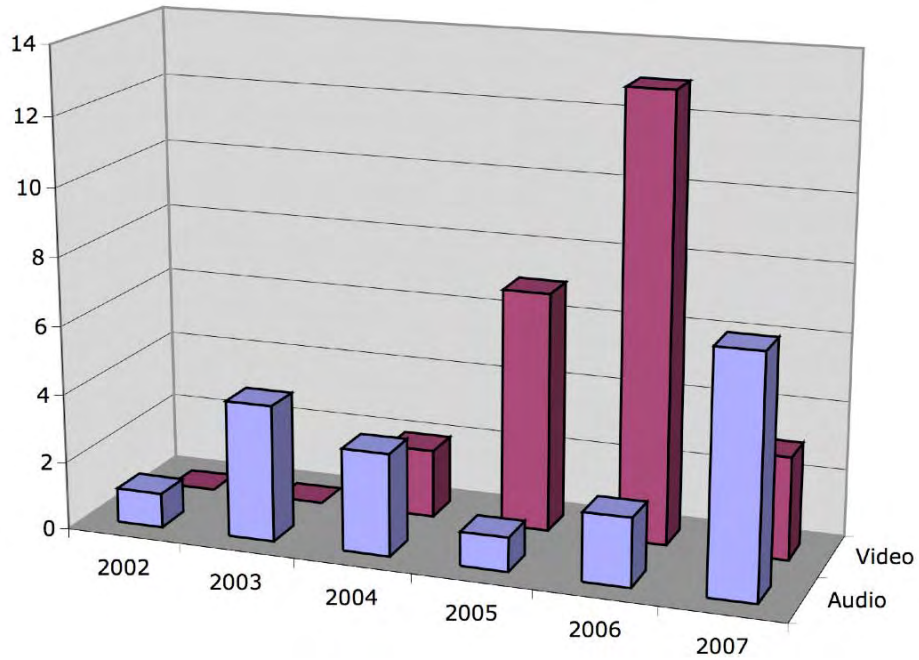

AYMAN AL-ZAWAHIRI AUDIO VS VIDEO (2002-2007*)



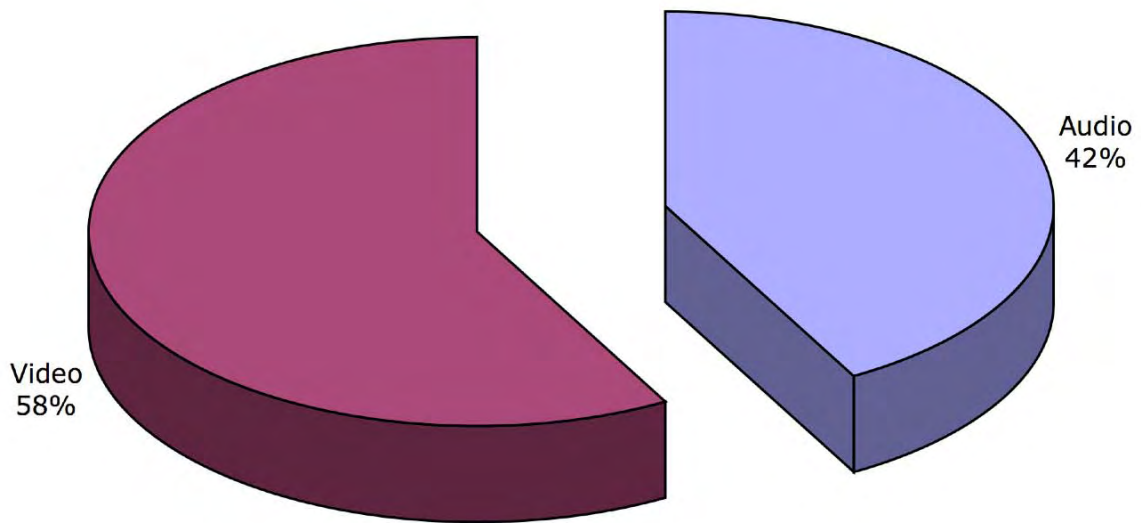

AYMAN AL-ZAWAHIRI AUDIO VS VIDEO - PERCENTAGES (2002-2007*)



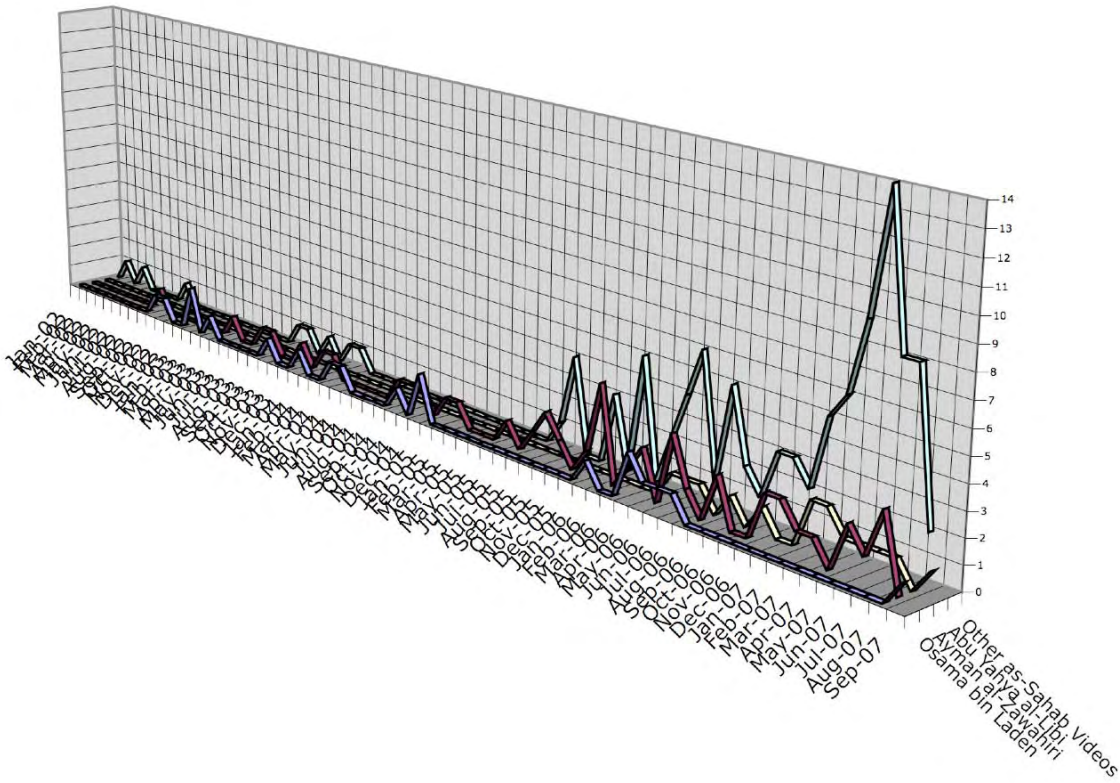

AL-QAEDA MESSAGING VOLUME CHART (2002 – 9 Sep. 2007)



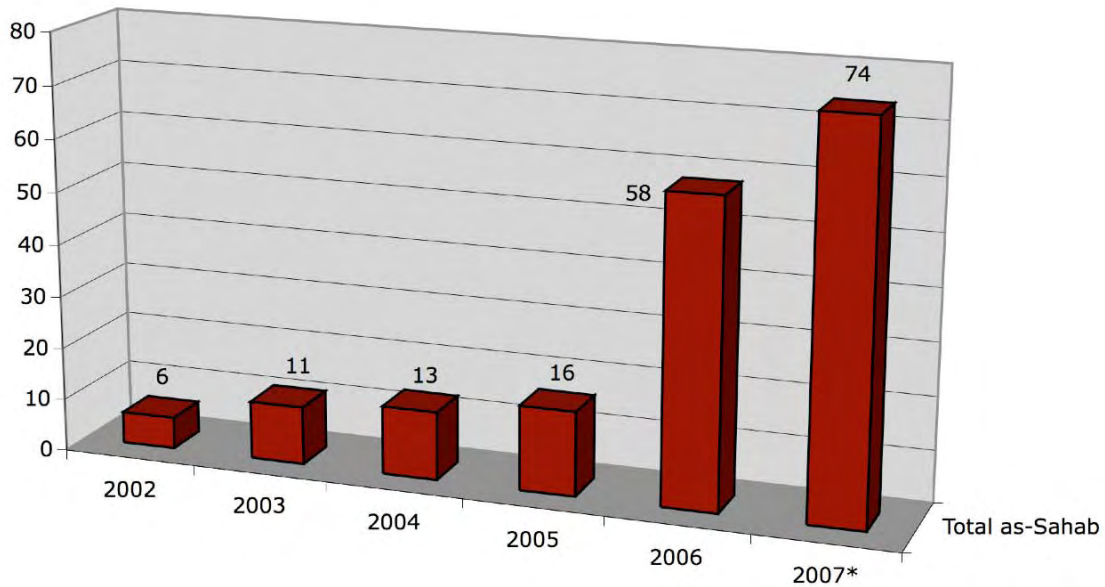

TOTAL AS-SAHAB AUDIO/VIDEO PER YEAR (2002 – 9 Sep. 2007)



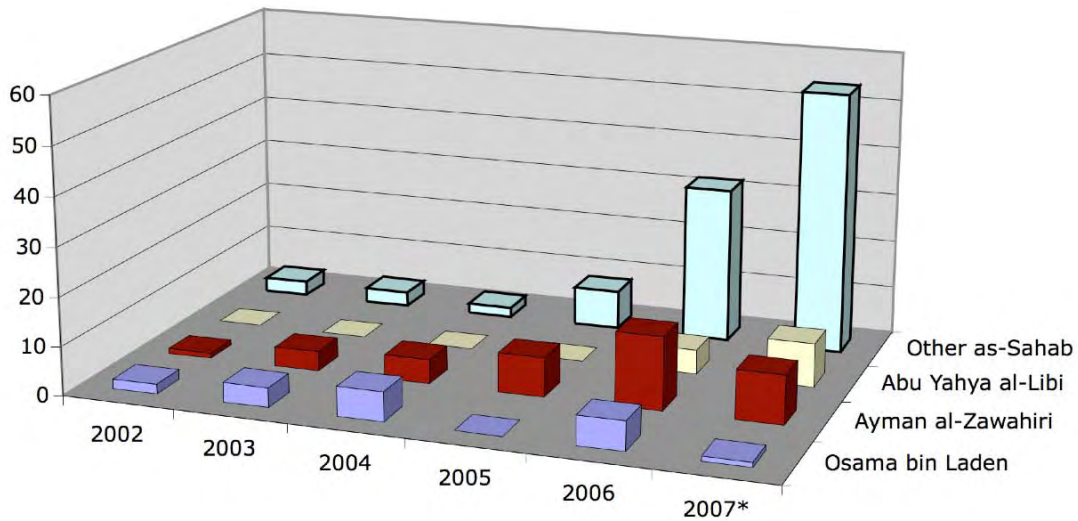

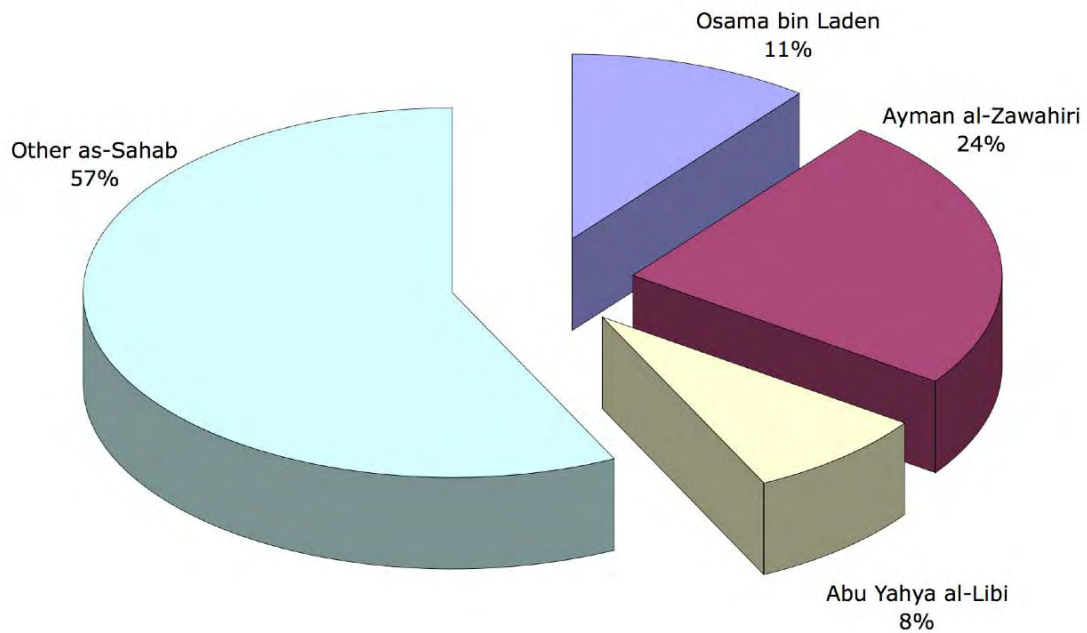

BREAKOUT OF AS-SAHAB AUDIO/VIDEO 2002-2007* - PERCENTAGES



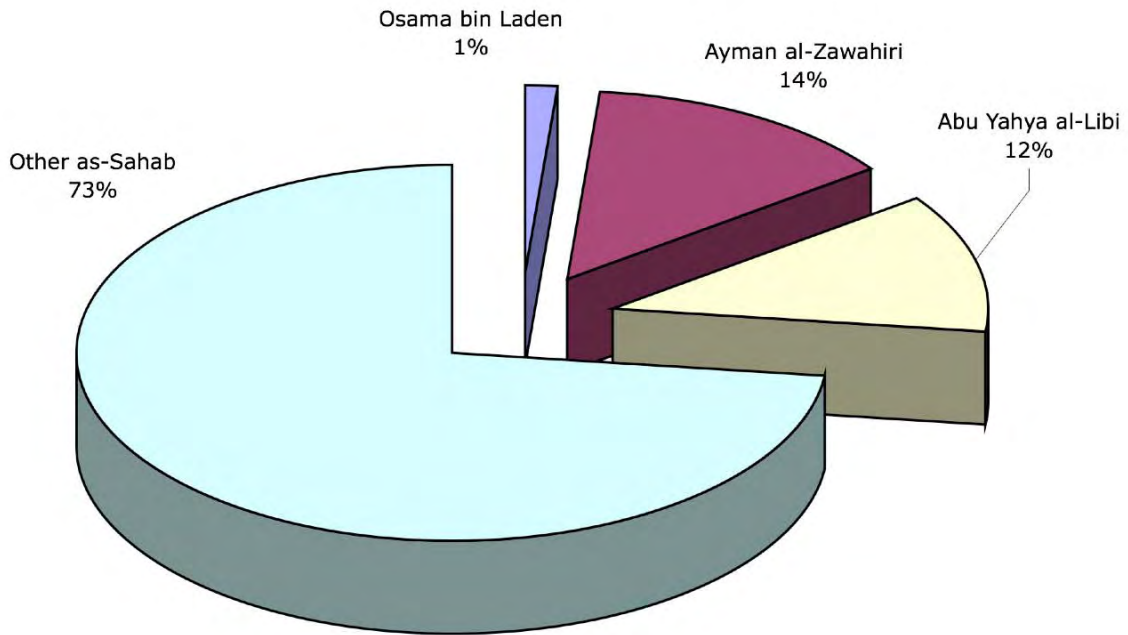

OSAMA BIN LADEN AUDIO/VIDEO PER YEAR - PERCENTAGES



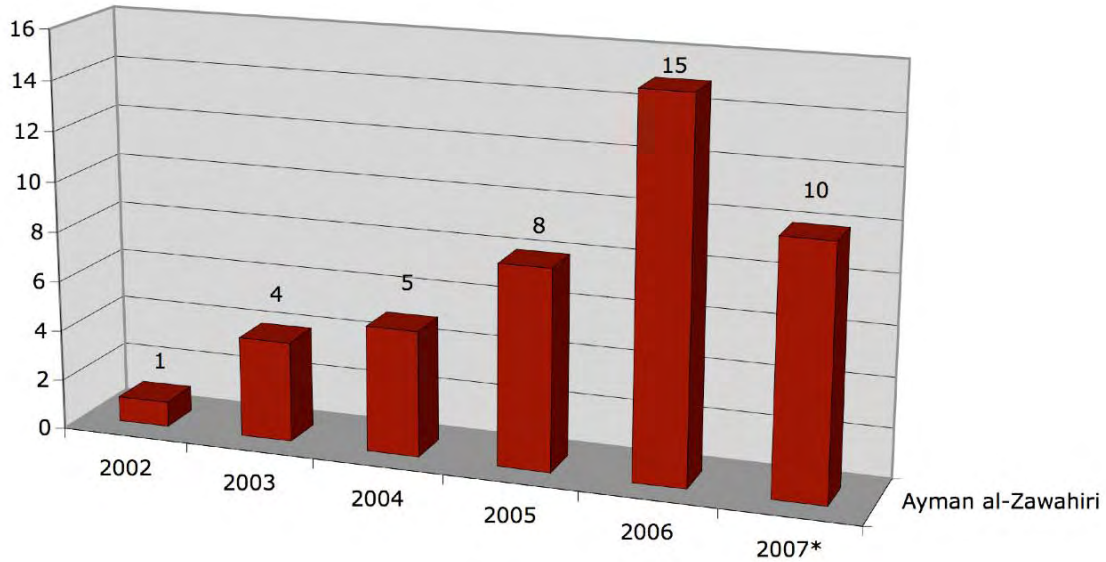

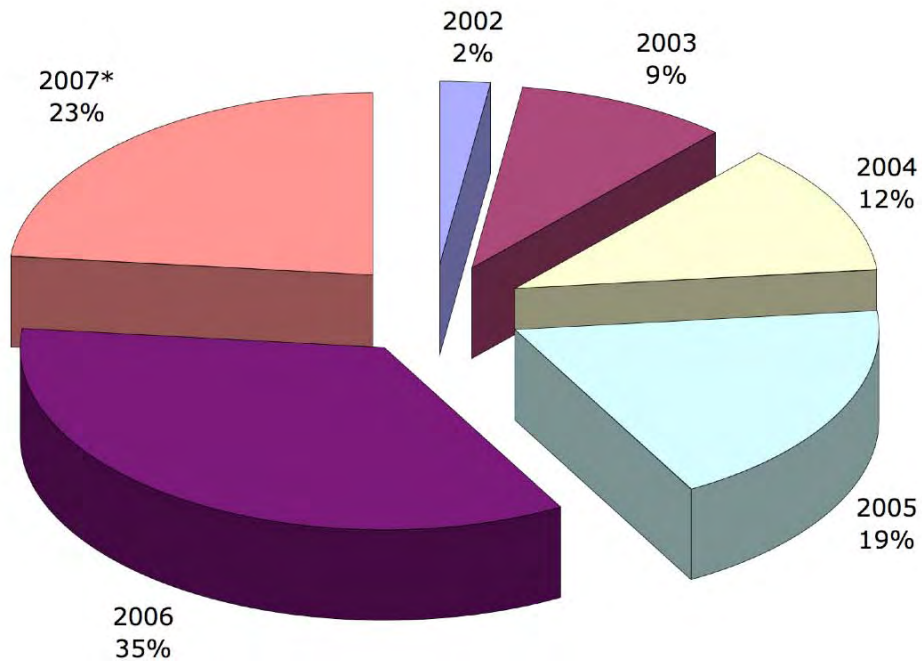

AYMAN AL-ZAWAHIRI AUDIO/VIDEO PER YEAR - PERCENTAGES



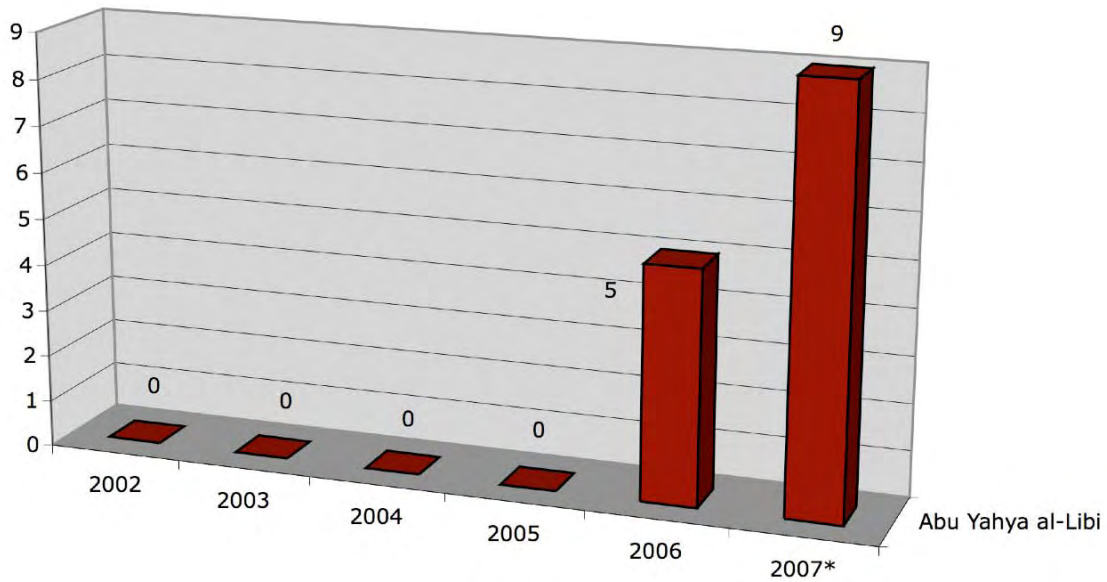
